Cubbington C of E Primary School – Safeguarding Message

Here at Cubbington C of E Primary School, we are committed to keeping everyone safe. This is a reminder of how we can all play a part in this, and also find out more information.

Why is keeping safe so important?

Children who feel safe are more ready to learn and make the most of the opportunities that are offered to them. Adults also need to make sure that they keep children safe and look after their own safety too. In our PSHE work we talk about 'early warning signs' that tell us when we feel worried or unsafe.

Who is responsible for keeping us safe?

We are ALL responsible for our own safety, but also to make sure that we help other people keep safe.

Mrs Jones and Mrs May are the staff members in school who are our 'lead' members of staff for Safeguarding – anyone can talk to them if they are worried. Of course, you can talk to any members of staff if you feel that you need to share something.

What should I do if I'm worried about myself or someone else's safety?

SHARE YOUR WORRIES - If something is worrying you, tell an adult you feel you can talk to. In our PSHE work in school, we talk about our 'network' of people we trust – but there is always someone in school who will listen.
