Parking

It is very important that parents park considerably outside school. Some parents are choosing to park on the zig zags or on double yellow lines and this is putting children at risk. We do work closely with the police and will report registration numbers if appropriate to ensure that warning notices are issued. Please help us to keep all of our children safe.

Arrival at school

We have noticed that some children in KS2 are being dropped off in the playground very early. The staff member is on duty from 8.45 and you must not leave your child unattended before this time. If your child walks to school by themselves then it is important that it is timed so that they arrive after 8.45am.

Late arrivals – lunch ordering

There may be times when it is necessary for your child to arrive to school late in the morning due to an appointment etc. Please can you ensure that you have made lunch arrangements for your child with the class teacher or the office before the appointment takes place. We order lunches from the kitchen at 9.30am each day and they are cooked to order so it can be difficult to accommodate latecomers if it is after this time.

Water

We expect all children to come to school with a named water bottle and it is helpful if this is full when they arrive in the morning. The children have access to filtered water in the classrooms so are able to refill bottles when necessary. We try to encourage children to drink water regularly throughout the day. It is important that it is only water in the bottles, we do not allow squash or juice.
