Children who do not follow the rules:


- Lose playtimes

But before we move on, we have some questions for you.

Do you let your children on the internet? When they're on the internet, do you let them go on Instagram and Facebook, when that app might be a little bit too old for them?

Well if you do, make sure you supervise them or even make their account yours, so then you can make sure they aren't looking at things they shouldn't be looking at or getting spoke to like they shouldn't be spoken to.

Don't let your child think that it's babyish for adults supervise you, because it isn't. It is a very clever idea and will make the child's time on the internet a lot safer. So therefore, if your child is getting bullied on the internet you can explain to them what they need to do.

But if your child is not letting you do this, don't worry because we have another solution. You can check on them just to see; when and if they leave the room, look on the device they were using and see if there is anything suspicious. Talk to your child and see if they will tell you what is happening on their device.

But if you have tried it and it still doesn't work, try to see if there is a different behaviour. If your child's behaviour is happy, sad or angry etc. that might tell you what is happening on their device e.g. maybe they are getting bullied or getting new friends. If it is one of those, try and talk to them and see which of them it is.
