Dear Parents and Carers,

It is lovely to have completed a full week in school and I know that your children will be absolutely shattered. They are all working so hard in school and the genuinely seem so pleased to be back. The teachers tell me that the classes have all settled so quickly and that the children are not phased by the continuous handwashing and new routines. Along every step of this journey we are constantly encountering uncharted territory, and this week we have been faced with managing children when they start to feel unwell in some way. Please read the attached guide very carefully as it gives clear instructions on how to manage a range of scenarios.

Please contact school immediately if your child develops one of the main symptoms of coronavirus. These are:

- **a high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (before taking any paracetamol)
- **a new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Please inform us when you have arranged a test and then when you get the result of the test back. You can email admin3144@welearn365.com at any time.

Social distancing

Please remember that it is important that parents maintain a safe social distance from each other and from school staff. Please don't be offended if staff step away from you if you approach them and you are too close. If you need a private conversation with a staff member please arrange an appointment for a phone conversation.

Teacher phonecalls

Over the next week class teachers will be making phonecalls to all families to have a chat about how their children are settling back into school. We would normally have opportunities for these conversations during the welcome meetings but as they happened virtually last term we want to offer an opportunity for you to have a conversation with your child's teacher. It is likely that these phonecalls will be after school or in an afternoon. The calls will come up as a withheld number so please answer your phone. If you do not answer the teacher will leave a message and will try again when they have called all other parents on their list. It is not possible for you to call back if you miss the call.

Message from the PTA

As you can appreciate this is a tricky time for fund raising for the PTA and we are trying to find different ways to raise the much needed funds for school. To this end we have recently organised an ink bin which accepts HP and Canon Inkjet cartridges. These will be sent back to the Ink Bin company who will refill them to sell on. I will be placing a basket in each playground for you to bring any used cartridges in from home and we receive a cheque every time we fill the bin.
